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NOTES

Welcome to this Beginner Crochet Tutorial!

I am so thrilled that you've chosen to learn to crochet with me. This is the very first project in our 'SO!...You Want to Learn to Crochet?' series and I can't wait to share it with all of you!

This free downloadable pdf is being shared to give you an idea of how my patterns are typically laid out. While this is a simplified version of my patterns, the layout remains the same!

I recommend reading through all instructions before starting your design. You'll find the materials list, abbreviations to describe the stitches used in the pattern and special stitches to review what steps you need to know. If you get stuck or have any trouble at all, please feel free to reach out to me!

MATERIALS

HOOK(S)

8.0 mm • US size L

YARN

Weight : Super Bulky

Hobby Lobby, Yarn Bee

Cozy Occasions, Soft Pink

- 1-2 skeins, depending on desired scarf length

Other Yarn Suggestions:

Bernat Blanket Yarn

NOTIONS

Darning Needle

Scissors

Stitch Marker (if desired)

GAUGE

4 inch swatch = 8 sc sts x 8 rows

FINAL SIZE

~ 52 inches

ABBREVIATIONS

ch	chain
sc	single crochet
st(s)	stitch(es)
yo	yarn over



SPECIAL STITCHES

SLIP KNOT:

A slip knot is needed to get started on your project. If you need help making a slip knot, check out pgs 5-6, the link [here](#) or QR code below!

CHAIN (ch):

Once you've made the slip knot, you'll work the chain next. If you need help making a chain, check out pgs 7-8, the link [here](#) or QR code below!

SINGLE CROCHET (sc):

After completing the chain, the rest of the pattern will be worked in single crochet stitches.

To make a single crochet stitch, insert the hook into the space, yarn over (yo) and draw up a loop. Yo again and pull through both loops on the hook to complete the single crochet stitch.

MAKING THE SCARF

This pattern is worked in rows. You will **always** ch 1 and turn at the end of each row. If you'd like your scarf to be slightly shorter, omit rows from the pattern. If you'd like your scarf to be slightly longer, add rows to the pattern.

As written, this pattern uses one skein (101 yards) of Yarn Bee Cozy Occasions yarn. Your total yardage required for the scarf may vary, depending on tension.

Row 1: To begin, ch 16. Working in the second ch from the hook and back across, sc x 15. [15]
Ch 1 and turn.

Rows 2-92: sc x 15. At the end of each row, ch 1 and turn. [15]
After the final row, cut yarn and pull the end through the final st to tie off.
Use the embroidery needle to weave the ends into the project.

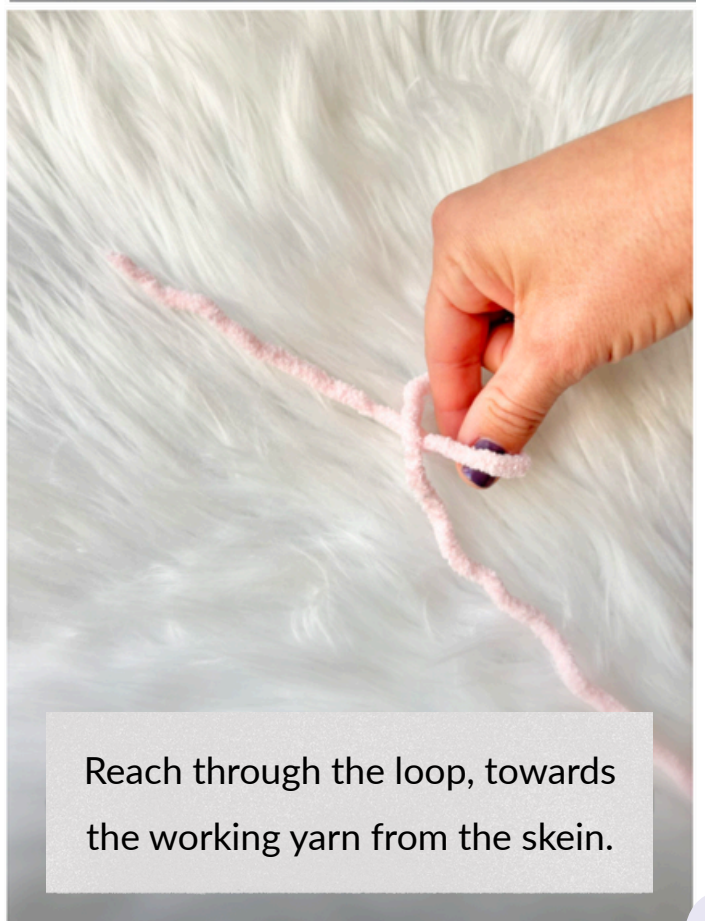
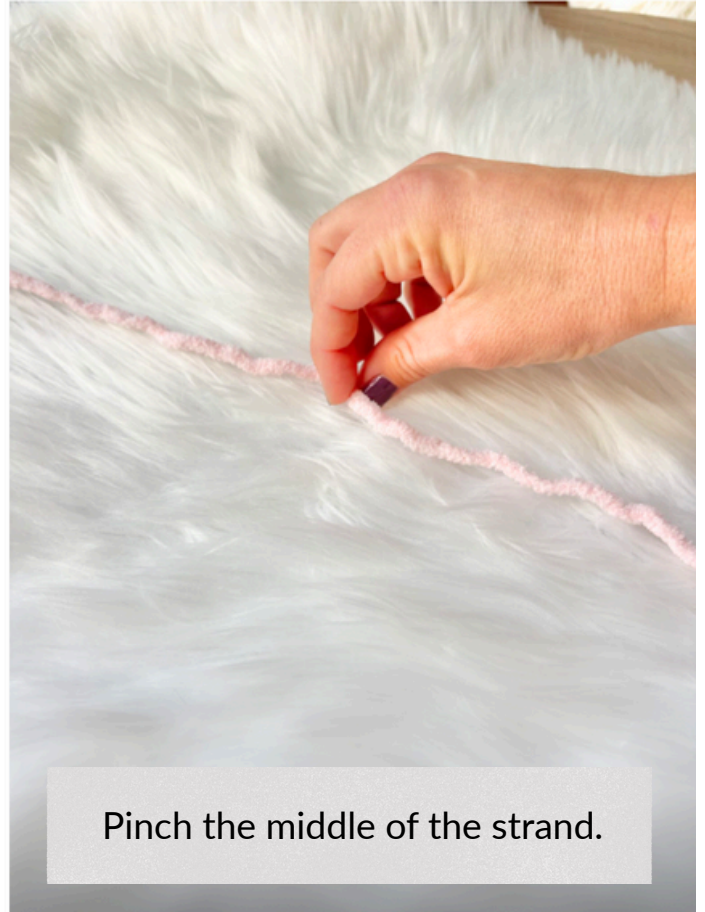
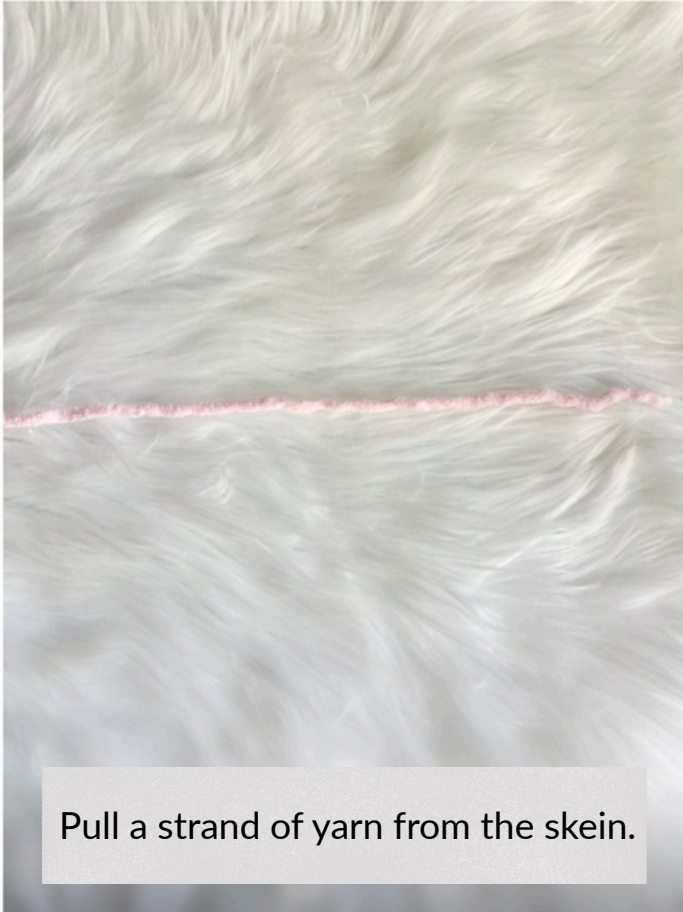
OPTIONAL: If you'd like, add tassels to the end of your scarf for some added flair! You will need additional yardage than recommended in the materials list to add the tassels. Cut 30 12-inch strands for each side of the scarf (60 strands total). Gather two strands and fold them in half. Loop them through the stitches on one end of the scarf. Repeat for each stitch along both ends of the scarf. Trim as needed!

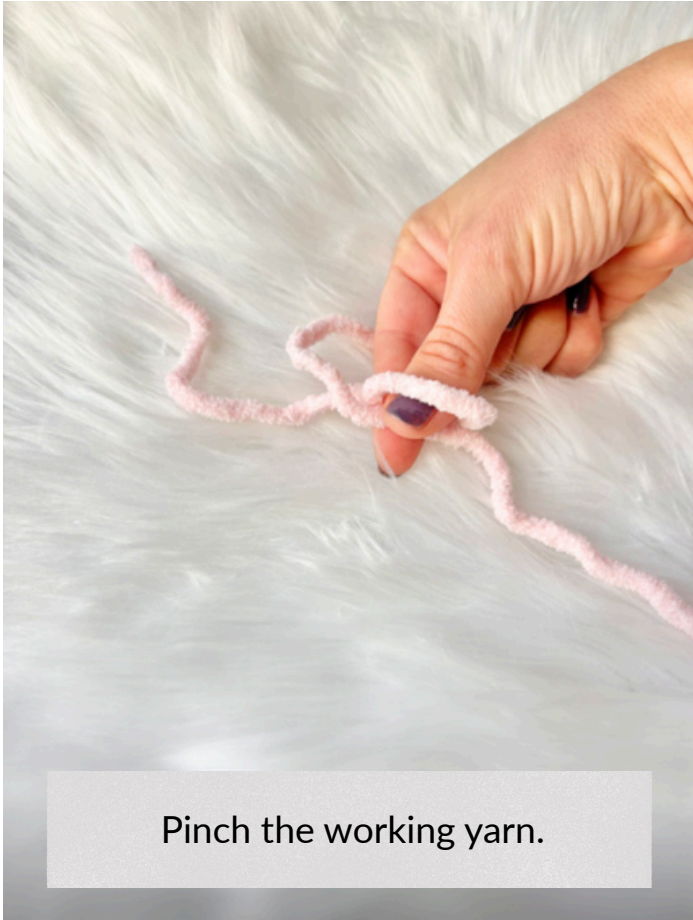

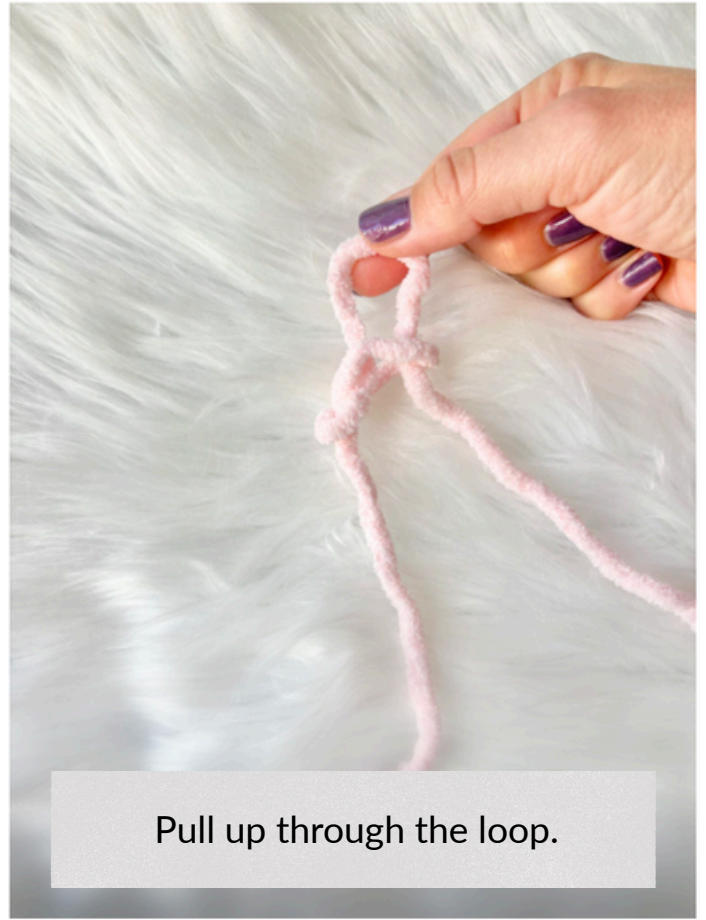
MAKING A SLIP KNOT:



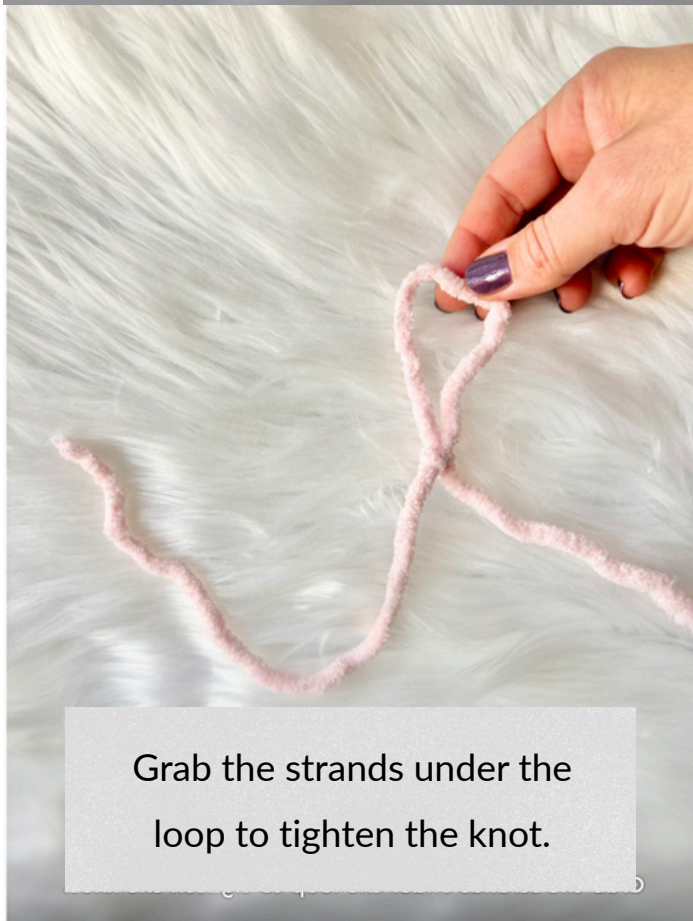
MAKING A SLIP KNOT:



Pinch the working yarn.



Pull up through the loop.



Grab the strands under the loop to tighten the knot.



Insert the hook into the loop and pull one strand to tighten.

WORKING THE CHAIN:



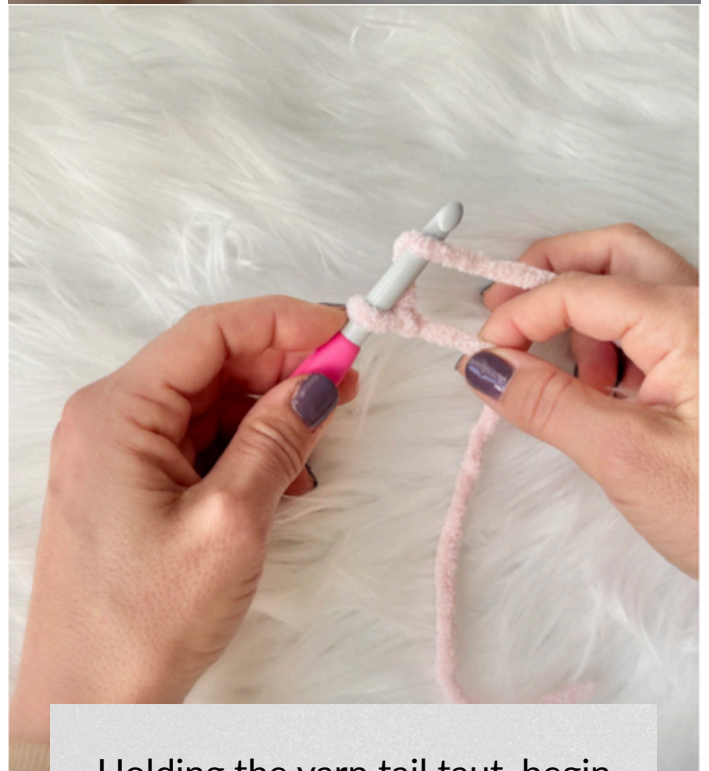
Begin with the slip knot on the hook.



Yarn over the hook.



Pull through the loop.



Holding the yarn tail taut, begin to pull the yarn through the loop.

WORKING THE CHAIN:



This completes one chain.



Repeat this process by yarning over for the next chain.



Pull through the loop to complete the second chain.



Continue these steps to work 16 chains total.

SINGLE CROCHET STITCH:



To begin a single crochet stitch, insert the hook into the chain or stitch space where you want to work the stitch.



Yarn over the hook.



Pull the yarn through the space.

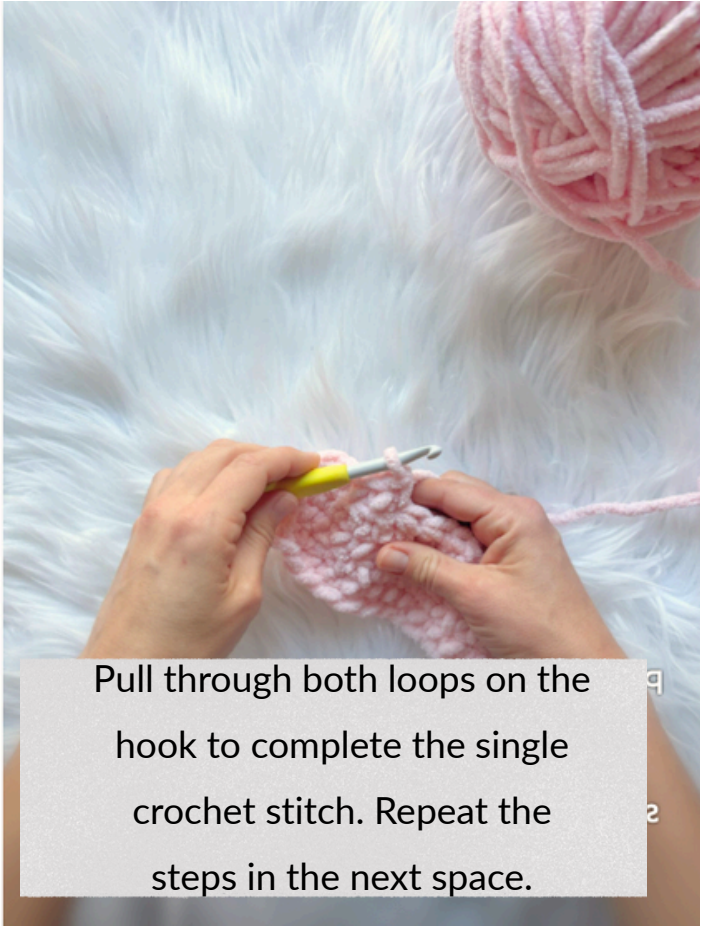


You will have 2 loops on the hook.

SINGLE CROCHET STITCH:



Yarn over the hook again.



Pull through both loops on the hook to complete the single crochet stitch. Repeat the steps in the next space.
